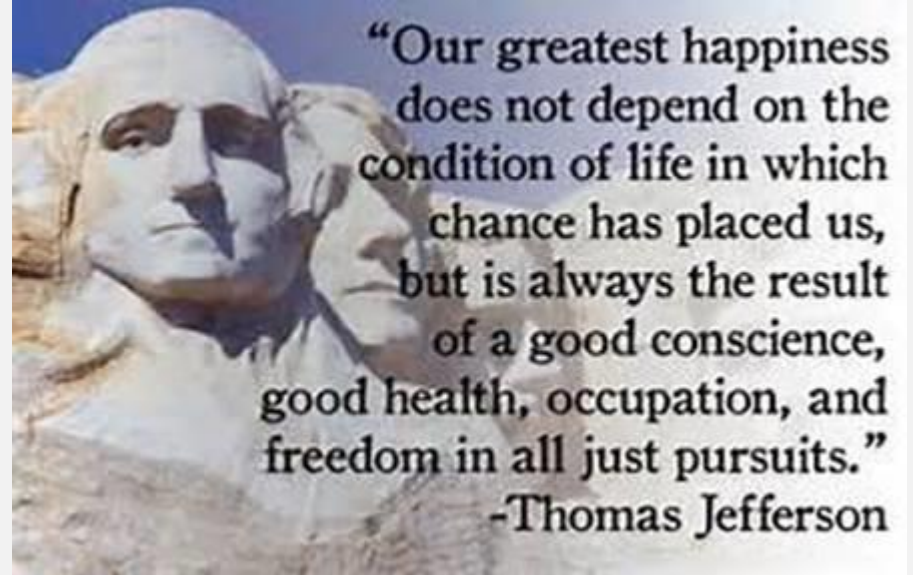

### Saul Alinsky's Rules for Radicals

- RULE 1: Power is not only what you have, but what the enemy thinks you have.
- RULE 2: Never go outside the expertise of your people.
- RULE 3: Whenever possible, go outside the expertise of the enemy.
- RULE 4: Make the enemy live up to its own book of rules.
- RULE 5: Ridicule is man's most potent weapon.
- RULE 6: A good tactic is one your people enjoy.
- RULE 7: A tactic that drags on too long becomes a drag.
- RULE 8: Keep the pressure on. Never let up.
- RULE 9: The threat is usually more terrifying than the thing itself.
- RULE 10: If you push a negative hard enough, it will push through and become a positive.
- RULE 11: The price of a successful attack is a constructive alternative.
- RULE 12: Pick the target, freeze it, personalize it, and polarize it.

Born in Chicago in 1909, Saul Alinsky was a Communist/Marxist who helped establish the tactics of infiltration that have been implemented in the U.S. government, media, and Hollywood of today.
