1: growing or produced by growth from deep tissue.

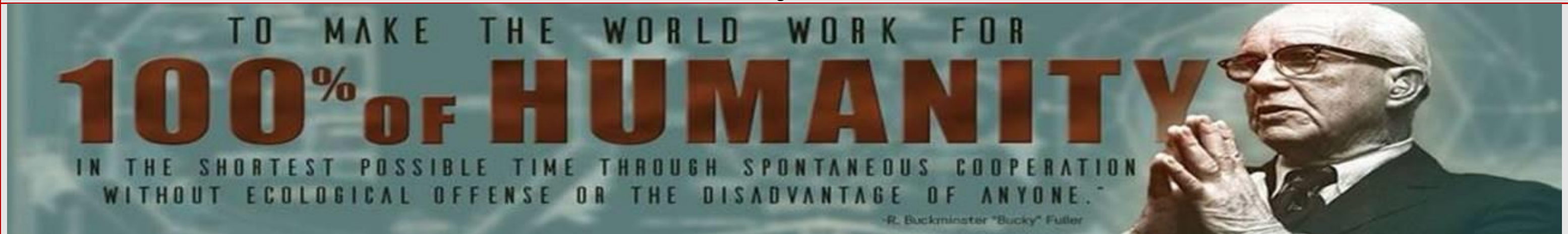
- endogenous plant roots
